



Funding and Scholarships 2009/10



Financing your Master is one of the most important aspects of the admissions process. At IE, we are very aware of this fact. We continually work towards improving accessibility to our programs by ensuring that funding is not a limiting factor for those students with the talent, ambition and drive to succeed. To that end, we offer comprehensive financial aid and scholarship options.

Financing your Master with a Bank Loan

IE has negotiated a special agreement with Caja Madrid and other local Spanish banks which allow students to apply for a loan offering favorable conditions to IE students. Caja Madrid offers up to a two-year grace period, amortized over eight years and with variable interest rates. All decisions regarding loan applications are made entirely by the bank in question.

Corporate Funding

Students who have arranged full or partial funding from an employer or third party must have their sponsor confirm their consent by completing the Corporate Financing Form. This form will be made available to students by the Admissions Department upon request and must be returned as an original document, bearing the seal of the sponsor.

Fundación IE Scholarships

Fundación IE works towards providing financial assistance to outstanding individuals who would otherwise be unable to attend IE. Fundación IE also offers scholarships in conjunction with other institutions, which play a significant part in the decision making process. The conditions associated to each scholarship are subject to change.

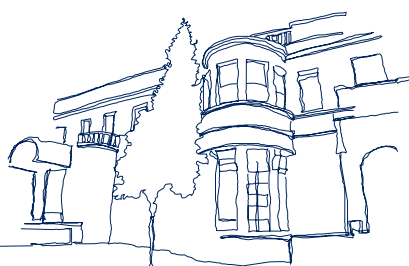
Program fees are for the intakes indicated within the academic year 2009/10. Fees are subject to change thereafter.

*The tuition fees do not include travel expenses or accommodation during residential periods.

Funds paid to IE as the place reservation will not be refunded under any circumstances, except when the intake is complete or the candidate has been granted "Conditional Admission" and the criteria are not met.
